

From Toulouse Airport: (Easyjet; Flybe; BA; AirFance)

- Follow signs for TOULOUSE (to get you out of the airport)
- Then follow the BLUE (not the green signs) for Albi - this will take you on the correct motorway – the A68.
- Stay on this motorway, heading towards ALBI. Come off at junction 9 – sign posted GAILLAC and CORDES.
- Keep following signs for Cordes (very easy!). Continue straight on until you get to a BIG roundabout with a BIG supermarket on your right. Turn right at this roundabout (entrance for supermarket is the next right at the next roundabout).
- Then when you leave the supermarket - turn right (heading into town). Continue down this road until you get to another roundabout.
- Take the 2nd exit (not sure what it is signposted - possibly Cordes?) It's more like 'straight over' this will take you pass a hotel on the right. Then you will come to a strange junction where you go Left/straight on ish over train tracks.
- Follow this road until you reach a t-junction with a (boulangerie - baker's) on your left. Turn Left. (Train crossing is on your right.
- Keep following signs for CORDES. You will eventually get to Cordes (about 20 km from Gaillac) It's a beautiful drive and a stunning town (on a hill). (well worth a visit during your stay)
- You will get to a VERY SMALL roundabout (ish) it's the first REAL junction in the town (town square on the right and there are lots of shops), straight on is St. Antonin but you want to take a RIGHT towards St. Martin LAGUEPIE. Keep following this road (initially down a hill) for about 15 mins.
- You will go down a VERY STEEP hill and round some extremely sharp corners - start looking for a RIGHT turn (after a long hill downwards and all the signs about an escape lane). Take this RIGHT turn down a steep hill to a T- junction - go RIGHT! You are now on the road that leads to the gite (D9 towards St. Christophe).
- Follow this road (10 mins) until you come to a fork in the road (there are some bins on the left) – take the right fork towards St. Christophe. (On your right there is an organic farm with plastic poly tunnels)
- LOOK right now – you will see a great view of 'The Tranquil Gite' complex.
- Take the FIRST RIGHT at the water hydrant approx 500 metres along this road. (If you go up a steep hill you have gone too far).
- Follow the road through the Hamlet (passing approx 4 houses) until you reach the grey and brown gates.
- Park either in front of the gates.
- WELCOME. Tranquil gite is the building on the right as you enter the gates.
